Dear Supporter of elite woman athletes,

You have been given this letter by a player, parent, or supporter of the Lady Magic with purpose of asking for your support and or donation. Lady Magic currently supports three teams; an 16u, a 14u team and a 12u team. All our teams anticipate playing a very tough schedule this fall, spring and summer in the preparation of qualifying and

competing in their respective National Championship tournaments.

The goal of Lady Magic is to provide young women, through competitive softball, the opportunity to develop the personal attributes and life long skills needed to become responsible adults. These young ladies compete at the highest level of softball competition for their age groups in the nation. The ASA youth program is among the nation's largest youth sports organization. Over 80,000 teams, 1.3 million players and 300,000 coaches participate in ASA youth softball on an annual basis. In 2008, Lady Magic's 16u team won the National Championship: the first 16u team from the Sacramento area to do so. All of the players on the 2008 team went on to pursue their education and play softball at prestigious DI universities on softball scholarships, and three went on to play on the USA Womens National Team. Our teams have enjoyed tremendous success since. Most recently, in 2014, our 16u team (now the 18G) won the prestigious Colorado Fireworks Tournament in Boulder, Colorado and finished 5<sup>th</sup> in the PGF National Championship tournament. To finish in the top group of elite teams at these prestigious national tournaments is a testament to the talent and dedication of these young athletes.

There are many expenses involved in competing at this elite level. Beyond the cost of uniforms, equipment and fees for local tournaments, both teams will be traveling extensively this season in preparation to return to the National Championship Tournament in their respective age division. Lady Magic does not pay our coaching staffs. All donations go to directly enhance the softball experience for the players.
